### FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Our most immediate challenges are repairing the existing church building and fulfilling the need for additional space. As you may know, shortly after my arrival to Resurrection, we noticed some irregularities with the support beams (i.e., mushrooms growing from the beams and leaks in the roof). We discovered that the exposed beams and the windows along the roof line have various degrees of rot and were leaking. Because these are the main support beams for the building, we immediately began a thorough process to determine the extent of the damage and the possible solutions.

In the course of evaluating our options for the remediation and expansion, we realized there would be significant cost savings if we added additional space to the church concurrently with the repair. We are now ready to move forward with plans to fix the beams, roof, windows, and expand the church by 1400 square feet. The expansion adds much needed space around the entrance to the church. It would be a multi-purpose space that would accommodate overflow seating for Mass, a cry room, and meetings.

The cost for the remediation and expansion is one million dollars. The GOOD news is we have \$800,000 in savings already. We are nearly there, but we need to raise an additional \$200,000 by the end of January 2012 to achieve our goal.

The project will take about 5 months and we will be able to continue to use the church for our regular Masses.
